#### Rates

Hotel room rates are based on:

Type of room (single or double)

Weekday (Sun-Thurs) or weekend (Fri & Sat) check-in

The following are **representative room charges** projected for April 2008:

Single, weekday room w/one double bed \$ 88.00

Single, weekday room w/one king bed \$120.00

Double, weekday room w/2 double beds \$115.00

Double, weekday room w/2 king beds \$120.00

Suite, weekday w/2 double beds,parlor,bath \$220.00

Weekend rates are approximately \$20.00 per day additional charge.

All rooms are subject to an 11% tax.
